AT NEWTON SOLNEY THE FOLLOWING CHARGING AND REMISSIONS PROCEDURES WILL BE ADOPTED:

On occasion, parents will be asked to make a voluntary contribution for, or towards the cost of certain types of activity, which cannot otherwise be funded wholly by the school. It is envisaged that activities will include: -

- i) school outings
- ii) visits by theatrical groups, musicians, authors etc
- iii) a voluntary contribution will be requested on occasions to cover the cost of various craft or cookery activities
- iv) a voluntary annual contribution for Forest School resources/snacks

Parents will be notified well in advance of the cost of the activity and the voluntary contribution they may wish to donate in order that the activity is viable.

No child will be excluded from taking part in any activity by virtue of an inability to pay if the activity forms part of the National Curriculum requirements or if it takes place during the school day. However, if insufficient voluntary contributions are received, it may be necessary to cancel the activity.
